Please pick up one blue athlete information card and one pink event tryout card for each swimmer attending tryouts. If more then one swimmer from the same family is trying out, separate forms for each swimmer needs to be filled out.

1. Please fill out the pink event tryout card with the swimmer's name, phone number, birth date and age as of December 1 only (leave all else blank) and hand them back in to the people at the registration table on the pool balcony. If there is an event/stroke that a child is unable to do, do not worry about it. We are judging the swimmers by what they can do.

*The pink event cards must be completed and handed in before the swimmer goes to the pool for try-out.

2. **Please fill out the blue tryout application card** (both sides) as completely as possible. The more information (e.g., previous best times) you can supply, the better!

*The blue application form(s) must be completed and handed in <u>before leaving today.</u>

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Each child will be observed and timed in each of the events that they are able to swim - there should be ample rest between each event. We are evaluating each tryout candidate based on how well the strokes are performed, "potential" (from coaches' observations), speed (actual times), and any additional pertinent information that we find on the application forms. Our goal is to place each tryout candidate into one of the YMCA's many aquatic programs (pre-competitive, competitive and instructional) with level appropriateness being the main objective.

Notification of placement will be made on Sunday 9/10/06 by 6:00PM. We will post this information on both the tryout page of the team website as well as on the team bulletin board that is located on the pool balcony.
